

Wolfgang Hip Hop Code of Ethics

Purpose

Claremont High School Wolfgang Hip Hop provides a select number of students the opportunity to develop and display their Hip Hop Dancing skills. It is a privilege rather than a right to be on CHS Wolfgang Hip Hop Team and with that privilege comes certain responsibilities. Foremost among these responsibilities is the adherence to Wolfgang Hip Hop Code of Ethics.

Wolfgang Hip Hop participates in a number of events at school and off campus. As a Wolfgang Hip Hop Dancer, what you do and the way in which you do it are often highlighted and place you in a public position that requires **exemplary** conduct. Your behavior has an impact on the reputation of your team, CHS and also on the attitude that others have toward you and your fellow team members. Your behavior will impact the performance of the team. You have been selected to participate on a High School Sport Team. Lastly, whether or not you so choose, you will be looked upon as role model and leader from your peers.

Definition

The CHS Wolfgang Hip Hop Code of Ethics provides general behavior guidelines consistent with the responsibilities of participation and representation. The Code of Ethics applies to all Wolfgang members, whether on campus or off campus. In simple terms, any conduct that brings shame to your team or CHS can be considered a breach of the Code of Ethics.

All Wolfgang Hip Hop members are expected to conduct themselves at all times with honor, integrity, good sportsmanship, honesty and humility. You are expected to treat everyone with dignity and respect.

As a Wolfgang Hip Hop Team member:

1. I will be respectful to others, parents, my coach and my team members.
2. I will not use inappropriate language.
3. I will be on time to all scheduled events and practices.
 - a. If I am more than 30 minutes late to any scheduled practice during the week of a rally and/or competition, I will not be allowed to participate in the upcoming rally and/or competition.
4. I will attend all practices.
 - a. If I miss a practice during the week of a schedule rally and/or competition, I will not be allowed to participate in the upcoming rally and/or competition.
5. I realize that I am representing Claremont High School Wolfgang Hip Hop team and Claremont Unified School District and that my behavior reflects on them.
6. I will follow all school rules.
7. I will be attentive, cooperative and appropriate at all times.

8. I will post appropriately on my social media sites, displaying a positive outlook as a team member.
9. I will participate in all scheduled Wolfgang Hip Hop events.
10. I will maintain a 2.0 GPA.
11. I will represent my team at all times in and out of uniform (No public display of affection)
12. I will not leave any Wolfgang Hip Hop event at any time without the approval of the coach or chaperone. If I must leave, I will inform the coach or chaperone before my departure.
13. I will treat all adult leaders and parent volunteers as professionals and follow all their directions with courtesy and respect.
14. I will observe safety restrictions imposed by parent drivers and bus drivers. I will treat these individuals with respect and appreciation.
15. I realize the coach or chaperone has the right to remove me from any activity/performance and report me to the school official for discipline and/or referral if I am rude, uncooperative and/or display inappropriate behavior.
16. I realize if I do not follow the Code of Ethics, I may not participate with the Wolfgang Hip Hop Team.

Violation of the Code of Ethics

Conduct or behavior that deviates from the expectations in the “Definition” section will be considered a breach of the Wolfgang Hip Hop Code of Ethics. Individuals who have been accused of violating and in breach of the Code of Ethics will meet with the Wolfgang Coach to discuss the potential violation, to explore the full extent of the breach and to determine the outcome.

Violating the Wolfgang Code of Ethics can result in the following:

- Loss of practice opportunities
- Excluded from Participating in School Rally, Community Event and/or Competition
- Removal from the Team

The Wolfgang Hip Hop Code of Ethics does not supersede or replace any Claremont Unified School District policy and procedures.

I AGREE TO THIS CODE OF ETHICS AND WILL COMPLY WITH ALL RULES. I UNDERSTAND IF I VIOLATE ANY WOLFGANG CODE OF ETHICS, I MAY BE BARRED FROM PARTICPATING WITH THE WOLFGANG HIP HOP TEAM.
